1. Covering letter
2. Personal details
This should include information about disabilities, if relevant.
3. Language capabilities
4. Further education and tertiary education
Give field of study, educational institute, start and finish dates, degree or diploma obtained (with grade).
5. Doctoral study
Give name of university, date of graduation, title of thesis, grade (if graded).
6. Habilitation (if relevant)
Give name of university, date of graduation, field
7. Professional employment history
8. Present position
9. Details of periods spent studying and working abroad (outside Germany), together with information on collaboration with international colleagues
10. Scholarships and fellowships held
11. Academic awards and prizes
12. Summary of relevant committee work
13. Summary of refereeing and reviewing work
14. Teaching activity
Details of courses taught (Bachelors and Masters level) and theses supervised (Bachelors, Masters, Doctoral). Include information on course evaluations, if available.
15. Research activity
Include 5-7 keywords to characterise each main field of research, refer to its interdisciplinary nature (if relevant), give details of active research projects.
16. List of publications
Separate into peer-reviewed articles (with journal impact factor), conference proceedings, monographs, other publications.
17. Citation details
Give details (H-index, i-ten index, Web-of-Science, Scopus, or GoogleScholar) for lifetime and for last 5 years.
18. Research funding
Separate into research foundation support (e.g., DFG), European Community support, other government support (e.g., BMBF), industry support, other support.
19. Outline of plan for future teaching
