### **Full Professorship (W3) for Geography of Global Change**

Fulltime position, start date: 01.10.2017 in the Department of Environmental Social Sciences and Geography.

This professorship is particularly suitable as a starting position for highly qualified early career researchers.

The candidate should possess an international research profile and be committed to research and teaching excellence in geography with a focus on environment and society-studies. She/He is expected to provide conceptual and methodological contributions to the multi-scalar analysis of locally and regionally articulated phenomena of global change and the development of society-oriented approaches to cope with these phenomena.

Further responsibilities include teaching and program coordination especially within the M.Sc. program "Geographie des Globalen Wandels" (Geography of Global Change, to be taught in German) as well as teaching and course development in other geography programs and in the faculty's graduate school.

We are looking for a personality who is highly recognized in the areas mentioned and has skills to interdisciplinary collaborations, successful project management and persuasive teaching. She/He is expected to build up an active workgroup that is well integrated in national and international networks. The willingness to actively attract external funding from public and private sources, as well as to engage in interfaculty activities of the university is required.

Prerequisites for the employment of Professors are a university degree, an outstanding dissertation and an excellent publication record. Substantial achievements and experience in academic research and teaching, at the level of a Habilitation according to the German academic system, are expected.

The University of Freiburg seeks to increase the number of female scientific faculty members and therefore strongly encourages qualified women to apply for the position. The university is committed to providing a family-friendly workplace.

Applicants with disabilities (Schwerbehinderte) will be given preferential consideration in case of equal qualification.

- Complete list of papers and invited lectures (including h-index and i10-index according to google scholar)
- Copies of the 3 most important recent publications
- List of current and previous projects including the financial support received

- Concept of future research and teaching foci.
